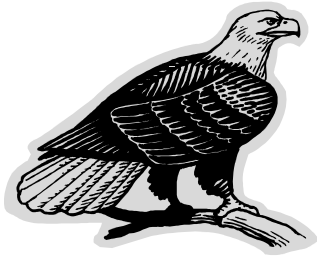

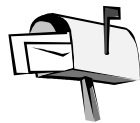
### FROM THE DESK OF THE WORTHY PRESIDENT
