FOE 190 200 CLUB BANQUET – Tuesday October 11, 2016

The FOE 190 200 Club Banquet will be held on Tuesday October 11, 2016. The doors will open up at 5:30PM with dinner being served at 7:00PM. You will only need to show at the door **your paid up** Eagles 190 membership card for the 2016-2017 physical year to be admitted. These yearly membership dues are due by October 01, 2016.

NO 200 club dues will be collected on the night of the banquet. If you are planning to remain in the 200 club, please fill out one of the brown envelopes by the drawing signup sheets located in the grill room with your name and number or numbers and deposit the brown envelope with your dues money in the 200 club mailbox. . The cost of one number is \$50.00 per year. You can also pay by check made out to the FOE 190 200 Club.

DUES BOARD TO BE USED FOR 200 CLUB - The 1st week of October we will post the 200 club existing members list. By your name, we will have the number of dues boards that you have so far this year. If you are planning to use your dues board to pay for a number, please indicate on the brown envelope your name number and amount of dues boards to pay for your number and deposit this in the 200 club mailbox. **Example** - One dues board is worth \$24.00. If you were using two boards to pay off your number, you will indicate on the envelope two dues boards plus enclose \$2.00.

Each member must contribute at least a minimum of \$5.00 prior to the 1st drawing of the new season which starts on Tuesday October 20, 2015 to retain their number or numbers. If this payment is not received prior to the new year start-up, the FOE 190/200 Club officers reserves the right to sell the members number to the first person on the waiting list that is a non FOE 190/200 club member.

The next scheduled payment of \$5.00 will be due by the first Tuesday in November, the 1st Tuesday in December with the remaining \$35.00 due by December 31, 2015. Please keep in mind you can pay the full amount off on your number or numbers all at once if you wish. This is being done for the members that may not have all of the money available at once to pay.

If you are planning to pick up your steaks they must be picked up Tues. October 11, by 5:00pm in the grill room. Also if you are planning to drop any of your current numbers you have at the present time, please drop a note in the 200club mail box in the grill room by the signup sheets.
