### Massillon Eagles 190 Annual Picnic Announcement

Dear Members:

Our annual Aerie picnic will be held at the K of C Pavilion on Sunday, July 21, 2019, from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm. In order to obtain an accurate amount of food that will be needed, we will have a sign-up sheet for the picnic in the Aerie bar starting on May 1, 2019, and running through July 7, 2019. The cost for Aerie members to attend the picnic is \$5.00 PER PERSON. Each member is permitted ONE GUEST which is an additional \$5.00. Members of the Aerie are permitted to bring their children under the age of 18 at no additional cost. We will ask you on the sign-up sheet to provide each person's name. Wristbands will be provided to you when you purchase your tickets in the grill room. Adults will have one color of wristband. Children under the age of 18 will have a different color. You will need to have this wristband on in order to receive your meal. Food will only be served from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. **Please note: Due to a head count for food, no last minute sign-ups will be allowed AFTER July 7th.**
